From a total of 900 submissions received by the parliamentary select committee, we were proud to submit 214 names from our kanohi ki te kanohi process last year. This number does not reflect the submissions completed online from whanau for personal and kaupapa based submissions. Last week, we presented our submissions on behalf of you, our whanau agencies and Nga Kaitiaki Mauri collectively, we will keep you posted as to the outcome..

Labour Ministers, Louisa Wall and Carol Beaumont have accepted our tono to meet with them in Hamilton, 4 June 2014.
